Brazilian origin products food safety concerns

To Whom It May Concern,

Following the recent international media reports related to potentially unsafe food products being exported by Brazilian manufacturers, and along with the Brazilian Government's published list of manufacturing sites undergoing increased sanitary inspections, Seven Seas Group has conducted a thorough internal check in all of its operating branches around the world to ensure that no such products have been supplied to any of our customers.

A full traceability exercise has been conducted, covering reviews in all stages of our food supply chain (in-transit, stocks on hand and delivery to customers) across the Group based on the Brazilian Government's manufacturing list.

After a detailed check, that covered all Seven Seas Branches, we can confirm that Seven Seas operations around the globe do not hold or have delivered product from the plants listed by the Brazilian government.

Rest assured that Seven Seas Group, as per normal quality practices, will continue to observe the situation by monitoring the health authorities' responses to the crisis in all the regions of our operations.
